ADULT & PEDIATRIC CPR/AED/FIRST AID COURSE

The Adult and Pediatric CPR/AED/First Aid course incorporates the latest science and teaches students how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age - adults (about 12 years and older) and pediatric (infants and children up to 12 years of age). Students who successfully complete this course will receive a certificate for Adult and Pediatric CPR/First Aid/AED valid for two years.

*The course includes a 2-3 hour online blended learning module that must be completed before we meet for in person skills.
